The Switch's Alumni Programme was formally launched in January 2023. It is a unique initiative that connects young people in East London with mentors, employers, and opportunities across 10 different industries.

In it's first 6 months the programme has attracted nearly 700 members, who have joined our online portal and participated in various events and activities. Some of the benefits that our members have enjoyed include:

- A bespoke Alumni portal with complex features and functionality
- A career support resource hub where Alumni can access CV builder tools, mock interview tasks and more
- A monthly newsletter featuring Alumni stories, industry insights, and job opportunities
- Recognition and rewards for their achievements and contributions through our new Ambassador Scheme
- Sharing their career stories and inspiring others through our "Celebrating Success" campaign


Ambassador Spotlight Sayful, Account Manager

A rich collection of resources and content. You can access webinars, videos, interactive activities and guides anytime, anywhere, and on any device.






Making entry-level opportunities accessible to all
