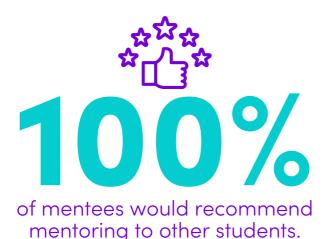
As a result of Mentoring students told us...

Student SpotlightMalaika, Year 12 Morpeth School

Malaika was paired with a mentor from Aon, she has always dreamed of moving out of London, but wasn't sure about her options, now she's considering a degree-apprenticeship in Leeds or Glasgow.

'I think before Mentoring I would just get overwhelmed with everything, but I've learnt how to tackle one thing at a time. I definitely feel more confident, and I understand better what employers want and what skills they are looking for.

My mentor helped me raise my aspirations and taught me what kind of work environments I'd be okay with and helped my understanding of what a working career would look like.'

When asked about how she feels about her future now, she said:

'I feel more confident in myself and my future, I feel like whatever I do I will be able to make the most out of it. Even if I think I want to do architecture now and I do things to get into that career, if I decide to go into a different career, I can use those skills and put them to use for something else.'

Mentors said about their mentees...



76% of mentors agree that they have developed their ability to motivate and develop a young person.

90% of mentors would recommend mentoring to a colleague.

"It was a rewarding experience for me as I was able to support my mentee with any questions they had. At the start my mentee was confused about what courses to chose from and [which] path to follow. Gradually, I felt she became more decisive and finalised on one course and path. This is a very challenging time in a students life when they can sometimes lack confidence in their ability, it felt great to encourage and motivate my mentee and to be a positive role model for them."
